

Here are abbreviated instructions for the wonky half log cabin (also sometimes called wonky quarter log cabin) block challenge

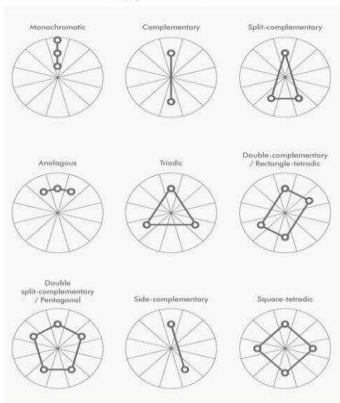
- The block looks like this, AND whatever you create needs to look like this in FORM, but not necessarily in these colors



- The deadline for submitting blocks has been extended until our meeting in September
- Robin will send out frequent reminders during the summer months to spur on your block creating
- We will be making ONE quilt to submit to QuiltCon in Atlanta, Georgia as part of their Charity Quilt Challenge AND [as many as we have blocks for] quilts to be donated locally in the Pioneer Valley area
- If you want your block(s) to be considered for use in the 2017 QuiltCon Charity Quilt Challenge:
 - Carson Converse is the project leader
 - The final quilt will be ~ twin sized -no smaller than 68 x 88, no larger than 72 x 92
 - there is a color palette that must be used. The colors that are listed in the QuiltCon link **can deviate from the colors on your computer screen** so please ask for swatches from Robin, Carson or someone you know who has ordered the fabrics. The white to be used is snow white, not the off-white that Carson included in her swatches
 - Prints are okay, but they must be these colors as well
 - Block sizes that you submit must be 3.5, 6.5, 9.5, or 12.5, so that the finished block in the assembled quilt will be 3, 6, 9 or 12 inches; all these sizes will be used in the quilt design



- Otherwise, use any colors you would like, but challenge yourself to use a color wheel in some of the ways shown here:

- The size(s) of the final quilts are to be determined
- Solids and prints are okay
- Block sizes that you submit must be 3.5, 6.5, 9.5, or 12.5, so that the finished block in the assembled quilt will be 3, 6, 9 or 12 inches; all these sizes will be used in the quilt design
